## 6. Parish Hall.

a. Planning has now been approved for the Parish Hall extension and 3 outline quotes have been obtained for the work. After discussion, two main actions were agreed:

To investigate funding via a loan from the Department for Communities and Local Government which would offer a favourable interest rate and grant RFO & funding via WREN, SODC, BIFFA etc.

To identify potential Project Co-ordinators with experience of running large/similar construction projects.

b. Members had investigated the various companies who had submitted quotes for the sand and seal of the wooden flooring and the renewal of the carpet tiles. After some discussion, it was unanimously decided to make the following recommendation to Full Council: Recommendation to Council

To engage ACH Flooring Services to sand, clean and seal the maple strip floor in the main hall and to include professional marking of the badminton court for the total cost of £3990 + VAT.

To also engage Oxford City Flooring to supply and fit carpet tiles to the appropriate areas and to supply and fit the aluminium cover strip between the wood floor and the carpet; the total cost (subject to confirmation) will be £4176 + VAT.

- c. 3 quotes for the kitchen deep clean have been received ranging from £445 £799. Cllr McTeague recommended Clean Genie who quoted £445 + VAT and this was supported unanimously by the rest of the committee. The work will now go ahead as soon as possible. Action: Clerk
