

Sunnyside

A recreational space for informal outdoor recreation

A recreational space located at the Parish Hall for formal and informal recreation. Includes a children's playground, tennis courts, a kicking wall and a small outdoor gym.

What You Will Find Here

- A large area of mown grass with marked out football pitches
- A fenced children's playground
- A small outdoor gym
- Tennis Courts (managed by the tennis club)
- A number of trees around the North and West perimeter with a mature hedge on the East and South boundary which has been 'laid' in the past
- A car park plus an overflow car park for the Parish Hall
- A kicking wall and basketball hoop in the North East corner

Technical Summary

Habitat: Mown grassland with trees and a hedge around part of the perimeter.

Play and recreation value: high

Management Summary

Designated as a Local Green Space owned by the Parish Council. Used for formal and informal sport, dog walking and general recreation / enjoyment of the outdoors. Also used as a community convening space for hosting community events etc.

Management Activities

- Regular mowing during the spring, summer and autumn
- Continue hedge laying and filling gaps / enhancing the hedging
- Additional tree planting
- Installation of bird and bat boxes
- Consider implementation of a bund / wildflower margin

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
